- -Host's rules/terms
- -amount of work-trade the Host expects
- -type of amenities offered to the homeless (type of space, shower, laundry, fireplace, etc)
- -Host's contact information

You may be able to have a 20 minute bathroom privilege in the morning if your schedule works out with ours, otherwise there is a restroom at the coffee shop across the street. Call us to schedule a 20 minute bathroom privilege sometime in the week(if you have children, time can be extended). We also have plenty of clean towels. If you need to do a small load of laundry, tell us and we'll see if we can work it out so this can happen while you're here. We are right on the busline between Ashland and Medford for those that have no vehicle.

#### Rules:

- -remember to be quiet so we call all try to get a good rest!
- -don't park in front of garage doors(leave 2 car lengths)
- -no unleashed dogs
- -pickup your doggie's doodoo
- -no illegal drugs
- -no underage drinking
- -no animals or smoking of any kind in the house

We want to offer a few safe resources to folks who are on the road or homeless, as we were traveling ourselves for 7 years. For this to be sustainable, we need to feel safe and at peace with who we open our home to. We hope it never comes to this, but we will ask anyone who we are not comfortable with, or who seems rude or inconsiderate to leave the premises at our discretion. Please don't take it personal if this were to happen to you: sometimes personalities clash! We look forward to building relationships with mutual respect & love. Thank you for understanding!
